- Please be kind, courteous and respectful of each other during these sessions and remember everyone's journey is their own.
- The group agrees to speak respectfully of any member of the lymphoma community including health professionals, health services and institutions.
- All participants will be adequately dressed during the session and will not participate if intoxicated.

- This is safe and positive environment where participants should support and encourage each other to learn, connect, gather information and share experiences with each other and your Lymphoma Australia support nurse.
