WHY DO WE NEED TO PUT LYMPHOMA IN THE LIMELIGHT?

Approx. 7,400 Australians are diagnosed with lymphoma (and CLL) each year and it is the number one cancer in the adolescent and young adult age group (16-29 years). Tragically, 1,700 die from lymphoma each year. There is no known cause and no prescreening tests.

Lymphoma Australia aims to reduce the impact of this cancer in the community through awareness, education, advocacy, support, and research. We want to ensure every Australian diagnosed with lymphoma has access to the necessary services, education and information free of charge.

FUNDRAISE


